Maurice John Light, born 8 August 1920, was the only child of John Henry and Ivy Maud Light of Paignton, Devon, England.

In 1943, Maurice, a member of the RAFVR, was in Canada at No. 32 OTU, Patricia Bay, BC. On October 15th, Maurice died of acute cardiac dilation. He was buried at Royal Oak Burial Park, Victoria, BC.
