**A Journey Through the Evolution  
of Unmanned Aircraft  
Systems**



**Ulrich Jaggi** served as an Air Force officer in the Canadian Forces for 34 years. During his career he completed several flying, test and evaluation, project, and instructional tours, including an exchange tour with the US Navy as a P-3 Orion project officer. He played a leading role in the early development of unmanned aircraft for the Air Force and received a Canadian Forces Chief of Defence Staff commendation for professionalism and

dedication in the development and fielding of unmanned aerial vehicles for the Canadian Forces. He has served as Director for Unmanned Systems Canada, holding positions as Vice Chairman, Communications Chair and Chairman of the 2011, 2012 and 2013 Annual Conferences. While in these positions, he had the opportunity to work with academia, industry, and government organizations, helping promote innovation and growth of the Canadian unmanned aerial vehicle systems sector. He currently works at the Naval Engineering Test Establishment where he is involved in the integration of unmanned aircraft systems onto naval ships.
